



City of Albany **Household Spring Cleanup**

The City of Albany's Household Spring Cleanup program provides city residents with an opportunity to dispose of their excessive household trash. Only residents who live in residential dwellings with four (4) or less units may participate in this program. **Trash should be placed curbside the evening prior to your scheduled spring cleanup day.** The schedule is as follows:

If your normal collection day is **Monday** and you live in Sheridan Hollow, Arbor Hill or North Albany, your spring cleanup is on **Monday, May 4, 2009.**

If your normal collection day is **Monday** and you live in the South End, South of Morton Avenue or East of Delaware Avenue, your spring cleanup is on **Monday, May 11, 2009.**

If your normal collection day is **Wednesday** and you live between the boundaries of Washington Avenue to Clinton Avenue and Manning Blvd. to Henry Johnson Blvd., your spring cleanup is on **Wednesday, May 13, 2009.**

If your normal collection day is **Wednesday** and you live between the boundaries of Washington Avenue to Madison Avenue from Manning Blvd to Lake Avenue, your spring cleanup is on **Wednesday, May 20, 2009.**

If your normal collection day is **Wednesday** and you live between the boundaries of Madison Avenue to New Scotland Avenue and Delaware Avenue to Manning Blvd., your spring cleanup is on **Wednesday, May 27, 2009.**

If your normal collection day is **Friday** and you live on the south side of Central Avenue (from Partridge St. to Yarbrough Ave.), North of Western Avenue, your spring cleanup is on **Friday, April 24, 2009.**

If your normal collection day is **Friday** and you live on Henry Johnson Blvd. (to Grant Ave.), north side of Clinton Ave. (to Northern Blvd.) including Shaker Road and St. Agnes Drive, South side of Clinton Avenue from Henry Johnson Blvd. to North Pearl Street, your spring cleanup is on **Friday, May 1, 2009.**

If your normal collection day is on:

Tuesday *your Spring Cleanup day is*
Thursday *your Spring Cleanup day is*

Tuesday, April 28, 2009
Thursday, April 30, 2009

Trash should be placed curbside, after 7p.m., the evening prior to your scheduled spring cleanup day. Hazardous Waste is **never** accepted curbside even on spring cleanup days. Please call the Department of General Services at 434-CITY with any questions regarding the Household Spring Cleanup.
