BASIC CREEK RESERVOIR ACCESS PERMIT PROGRAM **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

1. No swimming, boating, wading or bathing in reservoir.
2. No fires, hunting, trapping or picnicking.
3. CARRY-IN, CARRY-OUT! Please do not litter!
4. No minnows or other live bait permitted. Only worms and artificial lures allowed.
5. Do not trespass on other City lands or private property outside area posted for access.
6. Access permits must be carried while on City property.
7. No snowmobiles, ATVs, trail bikes or mountain bikes.
8. No person shall possess any cans or bottles except in designated parking areas.
9. No ice fishing – Area closed in Winter.

8. No person shall take fish other than by angling with worms or artificial lures.
9. No person shall possess any cans or bottles except in designated parking areas.
10. No person in violation shall fail to surrender access permit to Water Department staff.
