





 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ METAL & ALUMINUM <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Food & Beverage Cans • Deposit Cans 	<p>Include metal lids</p> <p>No need to flatten</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✗ Metal – Cardboard Containers (i.e. Cocoa) ✗ Foil wrap or trays ✗ Silverware ✗ Small Appliances (i.e. toasters, blenders) ✗ Pesticides, chemicals gasoline & paint*

 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ GRASS CLIPPINGS ✓ LEAVES ✓ BRANCHES ✓ BUSHES ✓ SMALL STUMPS ✓ CHRISTMAS TREES <p style="text-align: center;">  </p> <p style="text-align: center;">Please remove decorations, tinsel, lights, etc.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Do not place trees in plastic bags!</p>	<p>Grass and leaves must be placed in a biodegradable paper bag and placed curbside the evening prior to your collection day.</p> <p>Leaves should never be raked into the street.</p> <p>Branches must be bundled and tied together; should not exceed 4 feet 4 inches long.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✗ Stones ✗ Large Stumps ✗ Bricks ✗ Excessive Amounts of Dirt <p style="text-align: right;">✗ Entire Trees</p>
