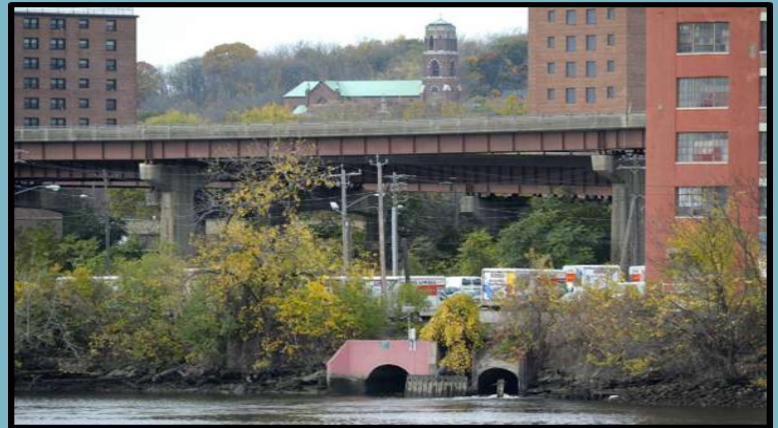

The Beaver Creek Clean River Project is the signature project of the Albany Pool Communities Long Term Control Plan, a 15 year multi-project plan to address and mitigate the water quality impacts of Combined Sewer Overflows (CSO's) to the Hudson River. The project includes screening and disinfection facilities.

The project will be located west of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd. at the access road to TOAST. The project will address sewer backups into the ravine to the south of Park Ave. between Delaware Ave. and Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd. and includes significant community benefit elements designed to work closely with the education mission of TOAST.

Construction is scheduled to begin in 2019, and be completed and operational in 2022.
